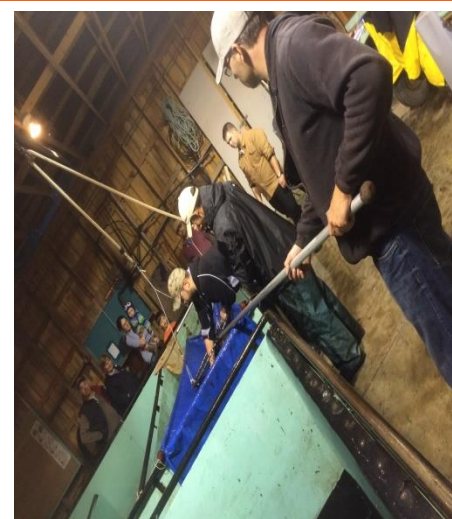
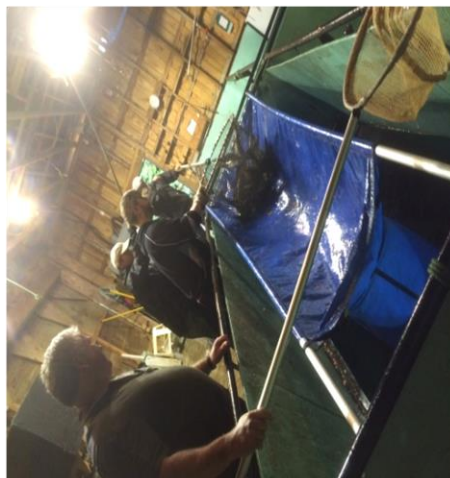
There were a few heavy days when **Chinook** and **Coho** came pouring in. **Pinks** were relentless in numbers and are now all but finished. Volunteers lined up to assist staff in moving through the heavy workload.

When fish begin to move it is imperative that we count them as quickly as possible and send them through our counting station at Lang Creek. Our hatchery brood stock is also being accumulated for the

eggtakes beginning in the next few weeks.

Flows in Lang Creek at month end remain relatively moderate. Temperatures are cooling at month end holding at 11 degrees Celsius.

Our Mill hatchery incubation systems have been activated. Flows are calibrated in preparation to receive egg production in the coming weeks.



Water Quality data collection continued with biweekly sampling of the Lang Creek Watershed). Routine sampling includes a test for color, pH, turbidity, temperature, salinity flow, and general weather conditions. The information is collected and used to compile an annual report.
